



# INPATIENT VISITOR POLICY

All visitors must check in and be screened at one of our screening stations prior to going to a patient room. If you do not have a sticker, you will not be allowed to enter a patient room. To protect our patients and staff, masks must be worn at all times during your visitation.

## NON-COVID AREAS

- Medical-Surgical/Stepdown: Up to four visitors at the bedside at a time.
  - There is no time limit on visitation
- ICU: Two visitors at the bedside at a time. ICU will be closed to visitors between 6:30-8:30 a.m. and 6:30-8:30 p.m. for shift change and patient care
- OB and Pediatrics may have up to 3 visitors at a time, including siblings

## COVID AREAS

- Two visitors allowed per day for up to one hour each. It does not have to be the same two visitors each day. Mask, gown, gloves and goggles must be worn during the entire visitation time. Visitors should remain in the patient room at all times during visitation. Children must be at least 15 years of age.

**Exceptions to this policy will only be made for end of life decisions and care.**

**Please note that if a patient transfers to another level of care,  
we will follow the visitation policy of that area.**
