

IMPORTANT NOTICE

INPATIENT VISITOR POLICY

All visitors must check in and be screened at one of our screening stations prior to going to a patient room. If you do not have a sticker, you will not be allowed to enter a patient room..

NON-COVID AREAS

- Medical-Surgical/Stepdown: Up to four visitors at the bedside at a time.
 - There is no time limit on visitation.
- ICU: Two visitors at the bedside at a time. ICU will be closed to visitors between 6:30-8:30 a.m. and 6:30-8:30 p.m. for shift change and patient care.
- OB and Pediatrics may have up to three visitors at a time, including siblings

COVID AREAS

- Two visitors allowed per day for up to one hour each. It does not have to be the same two visitors each day.
 - Mask, gown, gloves and goggles must be worn during the entire visitation time.
- Visitors should remain in the patient room at all times during visitation.
- Children must be 15 years of age.

Exceptions to this policy will only be made for end of life decisions and care. Please note that if a patient transfers to another level of care, we will follow the visitation policy of that area.
