Update to St. Bernards Medical Center Visitor Policy for Labor and Delivery:

Your safety and care are of utmost importance to us. As of Saturday, March 21, 2020, if you need to be seen for an emergency condition related to your pregnancy or you are in labor, please enter the Medical Center at the Main Tower Entrance on Washington Avenue. This is a convenient place for your support person to drop you off.

Please tell the screener at the entrance that you need to be seen in the Labor & Delivery Department on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor of the Medical Center. They will screen you and assist you in getting to the 5<sup>th</sup> floor as needed.

Your support person can park near this entrance or enter through the Red Level of the parking garage. The Main Tower entrance will be open 24 hours a day. The Red Level entrance from the parking garage will be open from 4:30a.m. to 9:00p.m. They will be screened prior to joining you on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor.

You and your baby, like all other patients in the Medical Center, will be limited to one visitor, who is fifteen years old or older, during your stay. All visitors will be screened prior to entering the facility.
