

IMPORTANT NOTICE

HEART CARE CENTER, CANCER CENTER & SURGERY VISITOR GUIDELINES

- All visitors must wear a mask at all times. A mask will be provided if the visitor does not have one of their own.
 - All visitors must stay in the patient room at all times.
 - Visitors must sign a Visitor Risk and Disclosure Acknowledgement.
 - Visitors who do not follow these guidelines will be asked to leave St. Bernards Medical Center and not allowed to return.
1. Visitors in the Heart Care Center and Cancer Center are limited to:
 - ONE adult who provides comfort care/end-of-life decisions
 - ONE adult who supports a patient who would otherwise require a sitter
 - No visitors are allowed in the Infusion Treatment area of the Cancer Center.
 2. Other visitors are not allowed to wait inside St. Bernards Medical Center. They must wait in their car or leave the St. Bernards Medical Center campus.
 3. Patients will have the opportunity to contact a family member by telephone or video. St. Bernards Medical Center staff can also call family members on behalf of the patient.
 4. Surgical patients will be allowed one visitor during the surgical procedure.
