

IMPORTANT NOTICE

WOMEN, INFANTS & PEDIATRICS VISITATION GUIDELINES

- All mothers and visitors must wear a mask at all times. A mask will be provided if the mother or visitor does not have one of their own. The mask must be changed when it becomes wet, soiled or damaged.
- All patients and visitors will be screened in the main lobby of the hospital and given a name badge before going to the patient care floor.
- St. Bernard's Medical Center will issue new name badge every morning. A current name badge must be worn at all times.
- Visitors must sign a Visitor Risk and Disclosure Acknowledgement.
- Visitors who violate these guidelines will be asked to leave St. Bernard's Medical Center and not allowed to return.

Labor and Delivery/After Delivery Visitation

- One visitor is allowed while mothers are in OB Emergency Department.
- A patient may have 2 visitors during labor and delivery.
- After delivery, a patient may designate 4 visitors with as many as 2 visiting at one time.
- Visitors should not leave the patient room after they arrive.

NICU Visitation

- NICU visitation is limited to two designated guests throughout the stay.
- You must schedule your visit because of space restrictions in the NICU.
- Both visitors are allowed at bedside at the same time if space constraints and capacity allow.
- You must remain in the room or the immediate area of the room at all times.

Pediatric Visitation

- Four visitors may be designated per patient for the duration of their stay and up to 2 may visit at a time.
- You must remain in the room or the immediate area of the room at all times.
